EASY CHICKEN & CHEESE ENCHILADAS

PREP: 10 MIN / BAKE: 40 MIN / SERVES ABOUT 6

1 CAN (10 $\frac{3}{4}$ OZ) CAMPBELL’S® CONDENSED CREAM OF CHICKEN SOUP
 $\frac{1}{2}$ CUP SOUR CREAM
1 CUP PACE® PICANTE SAUCE
2 Tsp. CHILI POWDER
2 CUPS CHOPPED COOKED CHICKEN
 $\frac{1}{2}$ CUP SHREDDED MONTEREY JACK CHEESE
6 FLOUR TORTILLAS (6”), WARMED
1 SMALL TOMATO, CHOPPED
1 GREEN ONION, SLICED

- 1. Stir the soup, sour cream, picante sauce and chili powder in a medium bowl**
- 2. Stir 1 cup picante sauce mixture, chicken and cheese in large bowl**
- 3. Divide chicken mixture among tortillas. Roll up the tortillas and place seam side up in 2-qt shallow baking dish. Pour remaining picante sauce mixture over filled tortillas.**
- 4. Cover baking dish**
- 5. Bake at 350 degrees for 40 min. or until enchiladas are hot and bubbling. Top with tomato and onion**
