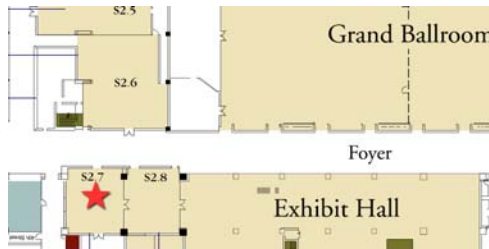

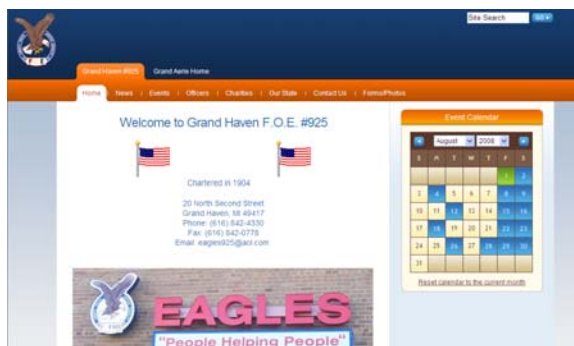

Tip of the Month:

You can copy information from one of your existing pages to a new page.

To keep the formatting, you need to copy from the original page's source code. This is done in the web browser. Right click any where on the page you want to copy and select view source. Then highlight everything you wish to copy and hit CTRL-C.

Now go to your new page in the CMS program. In the bottom of the editor window select HTML. Now click any where in the editing window and hit CTRL-V.

This will copy your HTML as is and will not change your formatting.

Make sure you only include the code for information you want to copy. Do not include any information that is between <head> </head> tags or has to do with menus. These will not work correctly in the new system.
