Our hosting company for the old server is working diligently to correct the problem and we are in daily communication to resolve the issue; however at this point in time, there is no solution. We will continue to work with the host on a solution and keep you posted as we learn more.

Server shutdown...

On February 27th, 2009 our contract with CI Host, the webhost for the old server, will come to a conclusion. Due to the increasing number of technical issues, and the creation of the new website management system, the Board has decided to not renew the contract. On February 27th the server will be shut down and all information removed.

Save as Copy

If you are editing a page you can now save that page as a copy. Just

hit the  button to do this. It will save a new page with the same title and keep any edits you have made.

Event Lockdown

Your events will no longer lockdown if another website adds your events to their calendar.

E-mail Gobbledygook

E-Mail addresses in event listings were adding extra information to users "To:" field when they were clicked. E-mail links are now behaving.

Table Wizard

The wizard is now live.

Friendlier Pasting

The editor now pastes information from Word and IE as is. Only removing unnecessary information.

MMS Auto Updating

This is currently being tested and will be live soon.

Tip of the Month:

Use the auto thumbnail feature in the insert image dialog box to re-size your photos.

In the editor hit insert image. Select the image you want to resize from the directory menu or upload a new image then select it from the directory menu.

Hit Auto Thumbnail above the preview area. You can then specify a size for the new image. Then hit ok. This will create a new image with a "t_" in front of the original file name. As in "t__original.jpg".

You can then use the image as would any other image you have uploaded
