Rules and Instructions

1. Entries will be accepted from members in good standing, their children & Grand Children.
2. Minor children must be accompanied by an adult.
3. All entries must be received by **June 3, 2019**.
4. Participants must report to a designated committee member 30 minutes prior to their scheduled performance.
5. Props and music to be provided by the participant. You must make sure that the tape or CD (if you will be using one) and any props are given to a committee person as soon as you arrive. Make sure you put the track number on the CD. You will then be seated as to the order of the time on the program.
6. Please also notify a committee person of how many microphones you will need as well as the type (hand held or in a stand)
7. Each act will be no longer than FOUR (4) minutes. There will be a ONE (1) point penalty for each THIRTY (30) seconds over the allotted FOUR (4) minutes.
8. The decision of the judges will be final.
9. An acknowledgement letter will be sent on receipt of your entry.
10. Medal will be presented to the top THREE (3) in each youth category and to the top THREE (3) in each adult category.
