URGENT COVID-19 UPDATE FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

As you are all most likely aware, Alberta has declared a state of public health emergency and has implemented new temporary health measures.

In order to remain open and operational, F.O.E. 2098 be enacting the Restriction Exemption Program (REP).

In keeping with Provincial REP requirements, effective September 20, 2021, the following will be implemented:

ALL persons entering the premises MUST be vaccinated. Proof of vaccination (paper or digital) will be required. Staged vaccination approach, as directed by the Province of Alberta, is as follows:

- September 20 to October 25, 2021: Proof of a single vaccination is considered acceptable as long as the vaccination was received at least 2 weeks prior.
- After October 25, 2021: proof of double vaccination will be required.

All activities associated with the Ladies Auxiliary, Men's Ritual and the clubs within our club (ACE, Crib, Curling, Darts, Eagle Riders and Pool) may continue as scheduled provided the vaccination requirements are being met and adhered to.

The Province of Alberta continues to deliberate and refine public health measures. We will keep you advised of any changes that impact us as they become available.

We thank you in advance for your patience, understanding and cooperation in helping us keep our doors open and our membership safe healthy.
